

2011 Park / Playground Policies by River Hills BOD

Based on our discussions with the Greensboro Police Department (GPD), the following is essentially a restatement of a previous policy related to rules and regulations at our Park / Lake / Playground / Walking Trails located at the termination of Spyglass Court.

- ❖ The Park hours will remain unchanged and will be open from *dawn to dusk*, corresponding to our existing signage in and around the Park area.

- ❖ The lake, playground, walking trails, basketball court, picnic areas, and surrounding common areas are for exclusive use by River Hills residents and their guests only.

- ❖ The electric access gate for vehicular traffic will operate only during daylight hours. Vehicles should not be parked or present in the parking area after dark. Vehicles should also not be parked at the end of the cul-de-sac after the park area is closed at dusk.

- ❖ Any River Hills resident who witnesses any illegal or criminal activity (use of alcohol, illegal drugs, vandalism, etc at the above named areas.) should report it to GPD by calling 911. Excessive noise, starting fires, and groups congregating after the park is closed should also be reported promptly. GPD has pledged their support to respond to your calls, investigate, and resolve any issues that fall under their jurisdiction.

- ❖ Remember our residents are our best resource to alert GPD to problems at our Park area and anywhere within our neighborhood. Board members or community volunteers are not trained or authorized to practice law enforcement, so please utilize the expertise and experience of our Greensboro Police Dept. The RH BOD will be contacted by GPD for follow up related to any arrests or actions taken as the result of their interventions at or near the Park area.
